



SHORT-TERM MISSION PROJECTS POLICIES

Financial Policy for Team Members:

- Team Members are expected to raise 100% of the financial support for the trip. Funding will be completed by the due date set by the Team Leader. No tickets will be purchased until the required funds have been received.
- Support shall be raised by the Team Member following the guidelines presented in writing by the Team Leader.
- If the Team Member raises support and is not able to participate in the trip for any reason, the support raised may be carried forward for ONE year to be used for another trip. If the funds are not used within one year, they will be reallocated to the Fellowship City missions fund. If more funds than needed are raised, the excess goes towards the team expenses. There is no refund for any overage raised.
- Team Members may submit financial support to Fellowship City Church (FCC) with their name and trip location printed in the memo field of the check or indicated on the envelope.
- Due to IRS restrictions on donations, refunds are not provided.

Behavior and Attitude Policies for Team Members:

- Team Members are ambassadors of Jesus Christ (2 Corinthians 5:20). As Team Members travel overseas, they not only represent Christ but also FCC, the United States, and the mission agency or church we are assisting. This is a tremendous responsibility. For this reason, FCC asks that each Team Member seek to be above reproach in his/her actions and attitudes.
- Team Members must submit to the Team Leader's authority.
- Due to the political instability and anti-American sentiment in various countries around the world, FCC asks that Team Members refrain from expressing political opinions while overseas. This includes wearing any clothing with political ideology on it.
- All Team Members must abstain from the consumption of alcoholic beverages or any use of tobacco or drugs on this trip.
- Each Team Member must adhere to the behavioral guidelines for the team set by the Team Leader and /or the missionary agency church we are assisting with a mind toward the culture of the country to which the team is going. This will require a servant attitude toward all nationals and other Team Members, as well as the willingness to learn from the host culture (1 Corinthians 9:19- 23a).
- The Team Leader reserves the right to ask a Team Member to return home if that Team Member's behavior is disruptive/destructive to the team, the ministry, or the host community. Any additional cost incurred as a result of this action will be at the Team Member's expense.

Any exception to these policies is at the discretion of the FCC Outreach Coordinator or Executive Team.
